

Which vehicle TO CHOOSE



The first thing to decide is "WHAT SIZE VEHICLE" shall we choose?"

We would always suggest you have the one that most fits your needs and lifestyle, which might indicate getting a larger vehicle than the one originally thought of.

For instance, there may be only two of you but would you like a home with a living/dining room and a totally separate bedroom with fixed Queen Bed, wardrobes and

cupboards? With FlexPlan pricing the costs may be similar to a smaller vehicle.

Don't necessarily be concerned about the length of the vehicle. Whether it is 20ft or 30ft long, it will have power steering, power brakes and automatic transmission. So all are very easy and comfortable to drive. All come with heating and air conditioning, on

board toilet and shower, often a twin-sink kitchen, a hob and microwave, and a fridge/freezer. If you wanted to you could stock up with food for your trip at the start and never need to find a Supermarket again!

Cruise America and Cruise Canada keep it simple by offering only three sizes of motorhome - all specifically designed for the rental market.



CT22

Small

Sleeps 3 adults; or 2 adults and 2 children; maximum occupancy is 4 people

With a Chevrolet or Ford truck chassis, the 20 feet long CT22 has power steering, power brakes, cruise control, automatic transmission, dash a/c, am/fm radio, 2 wheel drive, dual rear wheels and ABS brake System. Also a 37 gallon fuel tank, 11 gallon LPG (Liquid Propane Gas) tank, 30 gallon fresh water tank, 25 gallon grey (bath/washing-up) water tank, 23 gallon blackwater (toilet water) tank, 6 gallon hot water tank, 'fridge/freezer, furnace for heating, 3 cooker top burners, combination shower, toilet, roof a/c and small generator (USA only).

Beds include the 54 x 76 cab over bunk, a sofa-bed and a 38 x 72 Dinette conversion bed. There is also normally a microwave oven.

NB: There is no walk through access from the three-person cab to the main living area though there is a large 'open window' for emergency access in either direction.



C25

Medium

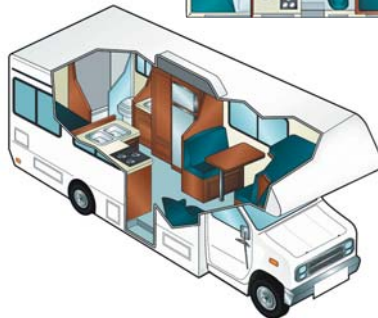
Sleeps 4 adults; or 2 adults and 3 children; maximum occupancy is 5 people

With a Chevrolet or Ford chassis, the 22 - 24 feet long C25 has power steering, power brakes, cruise control, automatic transmission, roof and dash a/c, am/fm radio, 2 wheel drive, dual rear wheels and ABS brake System.

This larger vehicle holds a 40 gallon fuel tank, 14 gallon LPG tank, 40 gallon fresh water tank, 38 gallon grey water tank, 30 gallon black water tank, 6 gallon hot water tank, 'fridge/freezer, furnace, 3 cooker top burners, microwave, combination shower, toilet, Generator (USA only).

Beds consists of a cab over bunk, 54 x 76 Dinette conversion bed, 40 x 70 fixed corner double bed. You can walk from the cab into the main living area in this vehicle.

Large

Sleeps 6 adults; maximum occupancy is 7 people so 2 adults/5 children or 4 adults/3 children is acceptable

Built on a Chevrolet or Ford chassis, this 28 - 30 feet long vehicle has power steering, power brakes, cruise control, automatic transmission, roof and dash a/c, am/fm radio, 2 wheel drive, dual rear wheels and ABS brake System.

The size of this vehicle allows a 60 gallon fuel tank, 14 gallon LPG tank, 50 gallon fresh water tank, 38 gallon grey water tank, 30 gallon black water tank, 6 gallon hot water tank, 'fridge/freezer, furnace, 3 cook top burners, microwave, combination shower, toilet, generator, 54 x 76 cab over bunk. 40 x 72 Dinette conversion bed, a sofa bed and a separate rear bedroom with Queen-size bed.
